The National Panhellenic Conference (NPC) is committed to our community, including addressing racism and racial injustice in our community. Our Board of Directors has outlined these considerations:

1. Our organizations do not reflect the diversity that our Panhellenic community. We don't make ourselves broadly attractive to women of color, including our Black and Brown sisters.
2. We believe that we must consider—and change—the systems that have historically benefited and centered the experiences of white women generally.
3. As a Panhellenic community, we have an obligation and responsibility to address racism and to openly discuss race and racial injustice.

In the near term, addressing these considerations will likely require the development of new resources and a commitment to support and work with our Black and Brown sisters, as well as having critical conversations with our Black and Brown sisters, as well
